

From Amistad to the White House:

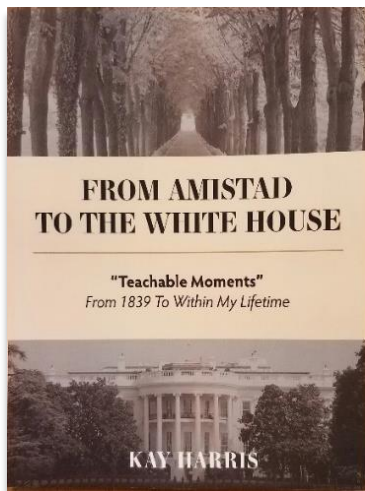
“Teachable Moments” From 1839 to Within My Lifetime
